

# Who Are We?

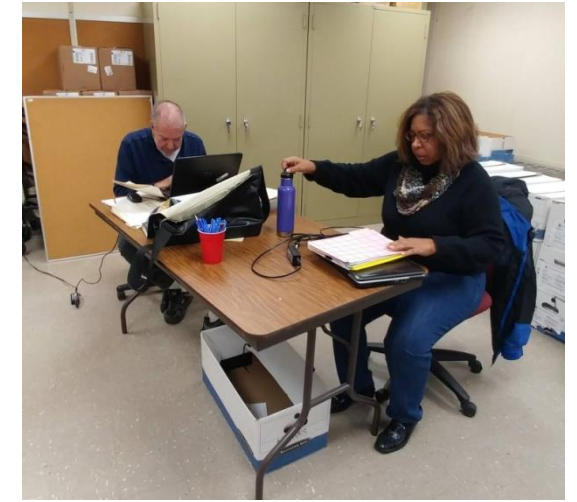
- Retired and current academics, a former US diplomat, a cartographer and experts in data preservation, the internet and library/information science.
